

Sons of The American Legion Petaluma

History

Founded in 1932, Sons of The American Legion exists to honor the service and sacrifice of Veterans.

Sons of the American Legion members include males of all ages whose parents or grandparents served in the U.S. military and were eligible for American Legion membership. Although Sons have its own membership, the organization is not a separate entity. Rather, Sons of American Legion, also known as **S.A.L.** is a program of The American Legion.

Many Legionnaires hold dual membership in the **Legion** and **S.A.L.** The Sons at the local level are called squadron, which is sponsored by a local American Legion Post.

The Petaluma **S.A.L. squadron** is named **Petaluma Squadron 28** and is sponsored by **American Legion Petaluma Post 28**.

The squadron is permitted flexibility in planning programs and activities to meet their needs, but must remember S.A.L.'s mission: to strengthen the American Legion four pillars:

- Pillar 1 - **Taking Care of Veterans**
- Pillar 2 - **Strong National Security**
- Pillar 3 - **Americanism**
- Pillar 4 - **Children & Youth.**

Eligibility Requirements

All male descendants, adopted sons and stepsons of members of The American Legion, and such male descendants of veterans who served during World War I, World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, Lebanon, Grenada, Panama, the Persian Gulf War and the War on Terrorism, during the delimiting periods set forth in Article IV, Section 1, of the

National Constitution of The American Legion, or who died subsequent to their honorable discharge from such service, shall be eligible for Membership in the Sons of The American Legion.

There shall be no forms or class of membership except an active membership.
